

Mostly Asked question (FAQ)

1. Whether an AMIE passed candidate is eligible for the post?
Ans: No, only departmental candidates i.e. employee of DVC with AMIE are eligible for the post.
2. I have an aggregate marks of 64.99% in Engineering and I belong to General/OBC category. Can I apply?
Ans: No, as per criteria General & OBC category candidates should have minimum 65% marks in aggregate. However, SC/ST candidate belonging to atleast 60% marks is eligible to apply.
3. Wrong E-mail ID has been entered by me while filling up the applications and I got the Online Registration No. Is it possible to change E-mail ID now?
Ans: E-mail ID once entered and submitted after receiving registration slip can not be changed. You have to register again with the correct E-mail ID this time.
4. Test Centre as Ranchi has been registered by me in the "ONLINE" application. Is it possible to change the centre to Kolkata now?
Ans: The test centre once entered can not be changed.
5. My current residential address is temporary and is likely to be changed at any time. So which address I should provide?
Ans: It is advisable to furnish the permanent address, providing temporary addresses can lead to inconvenience while delivering the correspondences from DVC. If there is any change in address, the candidates should in his/her own interest arrange with the post office concerned for redirection of the communication from old to new address.
6. I have forgotten to take the print out of Registration Slip. How is it possible to print the Registration Slip now?
Ans: You can download your registration slip any time by visiting the same website furnishing either your Registration number or other details as entered by you at the time of Registration.
7. How can I collect the admit card or when will you send the admit card.
Ans: For admit card you have to visit the same website as instructed from time to time to download the admit card by entering either your Registration number or other details. Admit cards will not be sent by post.
8. If I am finally selected by DVC, would I get the extension for joining time?
Ans: Normally no extension is given by DVC.
9. Can I get last year question paper or sample questions?
Ans: DVC does not provide any question papers to the candidates. However, question paper will be of multiple choice type from relevant disciplines and aptitude with 4 alternatives. Out of 4 alternatives, only one is correct.

Do I need to provide NOC at the time of interview?

If you are employed with Govt. Dept./PSUs/Autonomous Orgs., you need to provide NOC at the time of interview failing which he will not be allowed to appear in the interview.

11. My final year/semester result is not yet declared. Should I eligible to apply?

Ans: You may apply by providing % marks obtained up to pre-final year (i.e. up to 3rd year as appearing candidate). Your final selection in DVC is subject to submitting final year / semester mark sheet and provisional certificate. Also the aggregate marks should not be less than minimum qualifying % marks. In that case 4th row of the Online application form for marks shall be filled with 0 (zero) digit.

12. Whether I will be reimbursed bus or train fare during the written examination?

Ans: No such fare will be reimbursed for appearing in written examination.

13. I forgot to sign on the space provided on the Registration Slip. What should I do now?

Ans: Your application will be summarily rejected if it is found incomplete.

14. Whether Registration amount of Rs.300/- is refundable in case my application is rejected?

Ans: The Registration Amount once paid is not refundable.

15. I have done Bachelor of Engg./Technology in the disciplines which are not included in the 'Online application form'. What am I to do?

Ans: Disciplines as mentioned in the online application are presently needed and if you do not belong to the branch of discipline, you are not eligible to apply.

16. I have applied as SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) candidate but forgotten to submit the caste certificate with the Registration slip. What will be the fate of my application?

Ans: Since the required certificate has not been attached with the Registration Slip as instructed, your application will be summarily rejected.

17. I am an OBC candidate but belong to Creamy layer. Should I be able to apply the post as OBC?

Ans: OBC candidate means "**Non-Creamy layer**" only. Creamy layer OBC is not entitled to get OBC concession. Such candidate has to indicate his/her category as **General**.

19. My Institute awards DGPA/YGPA/Point on overall basis instead of % marks. What shall I do?

Ans: If the overall Grade Point is on 10 point scale, then Grade Point should be multiplied by 10 to get the % marks.

20. I am a candidate of disability with % disability less than 40%. Should I be eligible to apply for the post?

Ans: You are not eligible to apply for the post against PH category.
